

RULES & REGULATIONS

HOURS OF OPERATION: The beach facility is open from 9:00 am to 8:00 pm (or dusk), Early June to Labor Day. Hours and length of season are subject to change. Please see the BULLETIN BOARD for any important notices or changes.

CARDHOLDER RESPONSIBILITY: By acceptance of your beach card, the person thereon named, ("card holder") hereby releases and waives any right to ask for, or demand, damages for or on account of any and all claims, liability, loss, cost or expense (including without limitation attorney's fees) threatened, brought against or incurred by White Pond, for injury to any and all persons or damage to any and all property, arising out of the failure of the card holder, his family members, guests and/or any and all users of the card, to comply in whole or in part with any and all of the terms, conditions and provisions of these Rules and Regulations, or the failure of the cardholder to supervise and control his family members, guests and/or users of the card. The card holder further agrees to defend, indemnify and save White Pond harmless from and against any and all such claims, liability, loss, cost or expense herein enumerated. White Pond Associates is not responsible for personal property. We strongly urge card holders not to bring valuables to the beach.

PROCEDURES TO BE FOLLOWED BY ALL BEACH CARD HOLDERS:

- **Have beach card ready for check-in with parking lot attendants.** Card holders and guests must check in with the attendant on duty. If there is no attendant available, please see the lifeguard stationed at the reception table. (Located in front of the handicap parking area). Beach cards must be with cardholders when using the beach.
- **Parking in the Handicap Parking Spaces** is for those with a handicap plate or placard ONLY.
- **There is no parking in the drop-off area.**
- **White Pond parking lot is for cars with a parking sticker properly affixed.** Additional stickers are available for \$5 by writing to the post office box. There is no parking on Plainfield Road or on the county road. **All guests and guest vehicles must be accompanied by the card holder at the time of entry.**
- **Guest policy:** The beach card includes 10 guest visits with up to one family (parents and children) per punch. Individuals from more than one family each count as a guest visit. Duplicate cards with guest visits may be purchased for \$25 by writing to the above post office box.
- Duplicate cards without guest visits are available for \$10, also by writing to the above post office box.
- **Please notify the Waterfront Director or Head Lifeguard of any injury.**

BEACH RULES

- 1) **NO ONE IS PERMITTED ON THE PREMISES AT ANY TIME UNLESS LIFEGUARDS ARE ON DUTY!**
- 2) The Waterfront Director and Head Life Guard have the authority to take any necessary disciplinary action for the safety and comfort of those using the beach. Rules are subject to change by the waterfront director without notice.
- 3) RULES AS RECOMMENDED BY THE BOARD OF HEALTH:
 - a) **For children in diapers, we require swim diapers with a suit on top while in the water.**
 - b) **Soiled diapers must be changed on the changing tables in the bathrooms and disposed of in designated containers. Any changing of children's clothes must be done above the tie wall.**
 - c) **Always properly wash hands with soap after changing diapers or using the toilet facilities.**
 - d) **All children must wear proper swimming attire.**
 - e) **Children experiencing diarrhea should not be in the water.**
- 4) Toilet facilities are provided. Do not use the outside premises.
- 5) In the interest of erosion control and safety, there will be NO DEEP DIGGING OF HOLES on the beach. Only light digging with plastic beach toys will be permitted.
- 6) During unsafe swimming conditions such as thunder storms, overcrowding, or in the event the beach is understaffed, the Director or Head Guard has the authority to clear the water or limit the number of people on the beach or in the water.
- 7) Pets are not allowed on White Pond property.
- 8) No glass containers or alcoholic beverages are allowed on the premises.
- 9) No fires are allowed on the premises at any time.
- 10) During particularly heavy use times, the beach staff may temporarily close the parking lot.
- 11) An adult must accompany children under 12.
- 12) Children must be under the constant supervision of their parents or guardian. In the interest of complete waterfront safety, lifeguards will not handle this task.
- 13) Floats, tubes, and snorkels are not allowed at the facility.
- 14) All children must pass the raft test prior to using the raft (check with the lifeguard on duty). Children who have not passed the raft test **may not** be escorted to the raft.
- 15) Raft policy: No pushing, jumping off the back side, or swimming under the raft. Please use the ladder at all times.
- 16) Frisbee, rock throwing, or fishing are not permitted on the premises.
